### 2022 Camper Check-In & Check-Out Procedures

In an effort to provide a healthy week at Camp we will be following these procedures:

#### **STAGGERED CHECK-IN on SUNDAY 8/7**

**Woodside campers (ages 8-10): 3:00pm**

**Waterfront campers (ages 11-13): 4:00pm**

**Retreat Campers (ages 14-16): 5:00pm**

#### **DROP-OFF / REGISTRATION**

- All check-in procedures will take place within the open-air pavilion immediately to the right when you drive onto the camp property.
- No one is permitted to walk and/or drive onto the campus. We need to minimize any risk.
  - Bathrooms will be available near the pavilion
  - Camp staff will accompany the campers to their cabin where their counselor will be waiting for them.
- **EVERYONE**, including campers, families, and Camp staff, **MUST** wear face coverings during check-in.
- Please follow the instructions from the parking attendants. **Stay in your vehicle until instructed to get out.**
- All campers as well as anyone in the vehicle will be tested before they can begin the registration process.
- **Please note - If a camper OR a passenger in the car tests positive the camper will be denied entrance to camp.**

You will be using the test that you bring, and all testing must be viewed by a member of Camp staff. **All campers must have six (6) tests for the week plus one for each person in the car at check-in.**

#### **TESTING**

- We will be testing all staff and campers at various points during camp.
- We expect to have no issues, but reserve the right to test children daily as leadership and health staff feel it is needed.
- We have requested the tests for each day only as a precaution and will send any remaining test home with campers.

#### **FACE COVERINGS**

- All campers and staff are required to bring an adequate amount of face coverings to last the week.
- Please bring plenty, due to camp activities and environment.
- We must be prepared to mask at any time during camp and will do our best to keep masking at a minimum depending on the situation.

**PICK-UP for ALL CAMPERS Friday 8/12 1:30pm**

- All luggage will be brought up to the area around the pavilion and clearly marked by age group so you can identify your luggage.
- All check-out procedures will take place within the open-air pavilion immediately to the right when you drive onto the camp property.
- No one is permitted to walk and/or drive onto the campus. We need to minimize any risk.
  - Bathrooms will be available near the pavilion
  - Camp staff will accompany the campers from cabin area to the front where their parent(s) will be waiting for them.
