

The items below are our current updates regarding Camp Celiac's policies specific to COVID-19 for 2023. Please familiarize yourself with the items below PRIOR to registering for camp. These are subject to change as local, state and federal guidelines continue to be modified.

Great news! Due to the decreased need for additional COVID-related supplies, there will be no COVID fee charged this year!

As policies and expectations of COVID continue to evolve, Camp Celiac has made adjustments for the 2023 season. As always, the health and well-being of our campers and staff are our top priority. That said, Camp Celiac reserves the right to add additional regulations or potentially cancel camp for 2023 at any time for issues relating to COVID.

- Upon arrival to camp, prior to check-in, ALL campers and ANYONE in the vehicles:
 1. Will be temperature checked
 2. Complete a COVID screening regarding recent exposure to COVID
 3. Will need to self-administer a rapid COVID-19 test (provided by Camp Celiac) under the supervision of Camp Celiac staff
- Campers will be turned away and NOT able to check in if any of the following occur:
 1. The camper had a recent (within 10 days) exposure to COVID
 2. The camper has with a fever (100.4° or over as per CDC regulations), with COVID-like symptoms, or a positive rapid test
 3. Any individual in the vehicle has a positive rapid test
- Any camper with a fever (100.4° or over as per CDC regulations), with COVID-19-like symptoms, or a positive rapid test during the week of camp will require immediate pick-up.
- All parents/guardians must be reachable AT ALL TIMES during the week AND be within 5 hours of camp for possible early pick-up in an emergency.
